Mobile, on-site destruction of information systems media to NIST SP 800-88 Rev. 2 and NSA/CSS Policy Manual 9-12, with IT asset disposition, e-scrap removal, and technical consultation. Founded by a ten-year U.S. Army Signal Corps veteran with six years supporting the Intelligence Community; one of very few mobile providers able to destroy classified media on-site, and the only one based in Ohio. No whole device is ever resold: storage is destroyed, boards are smelted, and only data-free parts are reused. Your data security outranks our resale value.

Core competencies

- On-site destruction of hard drives, SSDs and flash, tapes, optical media, phones, tablets, and circuit boards, witnessed by your staff, with a Certificate of Destruction and serial-level media log written to NIST 800-88 and NSA/CSS PM 6-22.
- Degausser and solid-state disintegrator on the NSA/CSS Evaluated Products Lists by model number: Data Security LM-1 degausser; GigaBiter GB12 and GB16 disintegrators (2 mm); Allegheny 5HD3 hard drive shredder. All American-made, maintained with critical spares on the truck.
- Classified and SAP destruction at your cleared facility, in your custody, supervised by your cleared personnel. No facility clearance yet; we intend to obtain one.
- IT asset disposition and data center decommissioning: about 4,000 drives per day per trailer, serial capture against host, chassis and e-scrap removal by lift-gate box truck, R2-certified downstream with every effort to minimize exports.
- Technical consultation: sanitization policy and procedure, program reviews, and buy-or-outsource analysis.

Differentiators

- Destruction-first model. Storage is destroyed in front of the client; parts with no data path are resold only where the client's agreement permits.
- All staff are U.S. citizens with criminal background checks; many hold individual clearances through Guard or Reserve service.
- Mobile classified capability across Ohio and eight neighboring states and the National Capital Region; next-day service across Ohio and the states that border it.
- Buy American: equipment, trucks, tools, and supplies American-made wherever an option exists; allied nations next; nothing from hostile countries.
- Digitally signed Certificate of Destruction with a three-year audit right and a serial-level media log: two technicians, seals, customer approval, sensitivity, recycling partner.
